YWCA Project

- National charity supporting young women facing poverty, discrimination and abuse.
- Group established January 2007.
- Approximately 25 different attendees.
- Participants said: "My reading material is more varied now; I never used to read fiction. It's broadened my horizons."



CAN Project

- Charity offering support and services for people with issues relating to drugs, alcohol and homelessness.
- Group established January 2009.
- Approximately 8 different attendees.
- Participants said: "The sessions take place in a very friendly, informal, non-competitive environment....They have encouraged me to read more and to consider other types of literature and I enjoy them enormously."



Staff Project

- Created for University staff.
- Group established September 2009.
- Approximately 15 different attendees.
- Participants said: "A great way of getting to know people beyond immediate work colleagues."
