Authors can archive a post-print version of their paper, on condition that they provide citation to the source and link to it. We can supply a DOI to the archive.

Gold Access

There is no submission or publication fee for papers published in the Academy journals. To maximise access to original research, authors can opt for online publication, on payment of an open access charge. If an author wishes to take up this option, contact the [Publications Editor](#). The final published version may be deposited in repository.
